EXECUTIVE ORDER NUMBER ELEVEN

- WHEREAS, Article IV, section 9 of the Constitution of the State of Iowa provides that the Governor shall ensure the laws are faithfully executed; and
- WHEREAS, executive orders should be reviewed periodically to determine which executive orders should be amended, continue as necessary, or should be rescinded; and
- WHEREAS, some executive orders should be rescinded because they have outlived their original purpose merged or been subsumed by other agencies, councils and/or task forces; and longer exist, completed their work, are no longer active, and/or their responsibilities have or usefulness because the agencies, councils, and/or task forces have since been disbanded, no
- WHEREAS, some executive orders should be rescinded because the duties, entities, programs, and/or responsibilities created by the executive orders have been substantially or wholly codified by federal and/or state law; and
- WHEREAS, responsibilities created by the executive orders are no longer desired or are outdated; and some executive orders should be rescinded because the duties, entities, programs, and/or
- WHEREAS, to ensure an efficient and effective state executive orders that are amended, expired, rescinded, or superseded clearly ascertainable; and government, the final disposition of should be
- WHEREAS, all executive orders remain in effect unless they expire on their own terms, are rescinded, or superseded; and
