

Open records information provided by the Office of the Governor in June 2012

- On average, responses were provided within 8 days

On June 5, 2012, Mike Wiser, Lee Enterprises, requested copies of the Governor's Office Internet and email usage policy along with records of any violations of the policy from staff. On June 7, 2012, our office provided three pages in hard copy. There was no charge for this request.

On June 8, 2012, Ryan Foley, The Associated Press, requested Governor Branstad's report to the legislature regarding all executive clemencies granted in 2011, copies of restoration of voting rights granted for 2012, and copies of letters to applicants with incomplete applications. On June 14, 2012, our office provided thirteen (13) pages in hard copy. There was no charge for this request.

On June 6, 2012, Alissa Skelton, Chanel 21 News and Arizona State University, requested a copy of all Executive Clemency Decisions from January 14, 2011 – June 6, 2012. Additionally, she requested a copy of the voting applications. On June 27, 2012, our office provided 38 pages in hard copy. There was a charge of \$2.80 for copies.

On June 5, 2012, Mike Wiser, Lee Enterprises, requested copies of the Governor's full official schedule from January 1, 2012 – June 5, 2012. On June 29, 2012, our office provided 95 pages in hard copy. There was a charge of \$8.50 for copies.
