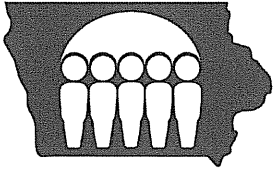

- \$60,000.00 for IDCM for Hancock, Humboldt, Plymouth, Sioux, and Winnebago Counties



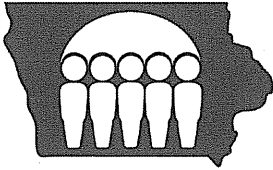

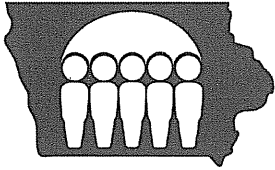

- Reporting/Invoices: Fiscal Staff


