**EXTENSION OF PROCLAMATION OF DISASTER EMERGENCY
ISSUED SEPTEMBER 4, 2012**

WHEREAS, On the 4th day of September, 2012, I issued a Proclamation of Disaster Emergency in response to the ongoing drought in the State of Iowa and the effect the drought has had on the harvest of crops; and


WHEREAS, While many Iowa farmers have completed harvest, effects of the drought continue and the circumstances and reasons for issuance of the proclamation remain and continue as there still are Iowa farmers who continue to harvest crops; and

WHEREAS, Significant movement of grain continues throughout the state between on-farm storage and points of sale and between grain cooperatives and elevators and rail or river terminals; and

WHEREAS, Strict compliance with the permit and fee requirements of Iowa Code §§ 321E.29, 321.454, 326.463 and 761 Iowa Admin. Code 511 allowing oversize and overweight divisible loads under certain circumstances would continue to prevent or hinder efforts to cope with the harvest and movement of grain in our state.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Terry E. Branstad, Governor of the State of Iowa, by the power and authority invested in me by the Iowa Constitution, Article IV Sections 1 and 8, and Iowa Code §29C.6(1), do hereby extend for fifteen (15) days the state of disaster emergency for the entire state of Iowa originally proclaimed on September 4, 2012. All terms and conditions of the proclamation of September 4, 2012 are hereby referenced and shall continue to apply as if fully set forth in this document.

This extension to the original proclamation shall become effective at 12:01 a.m. on November 3, 2012, and shall expire fifteen (15) days from the date issued. The Iowa Department of Transportation is hereby directed to continue to monitor the operation of this proclamation to assure the public's safety and facilitate the movement of trucks involved in our state's harvest.
